ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION

3 DAY, 2 NIGHT LAGOON SNORKEL PROGRAM

This is the basic MarineLab program for elementary students. It includes a lagoon snorkel (for snorkeling practice), and three snorkeling field trips to the seagrasses, mangroves, and at least two different coral reef areas. Evening activities include the invertebrate diversity lab, the plankton tow, the reef ecology discussion and the field identification of reef fish discussion.
