

## **MARINELAB TEACHER WORKSHOPS – GENERAL INFORMATION**

### **HOUSING**

The air-conditioned dorm style rooms contain up to 16 people and are sex-segregated. Beds come with twin linens, a pillow, and a blanket. Room keys are not available. Anything especially valuable should be left at home. However, cameras and personal items are safe in the rooms, or you may lock them in your car. Toilet and shower facilities are on the first floor. These are large rooms with enclosed stalls and showers. You will probably want a robe to wear to and from the showers.

### **MEALS**

Meals are taken in our air conditioned cafeteria and consist of mainly institutional-type food.
