

Coral Restoration Workshop with Mote Marine Lab

This program is led by a Mote Marine Lab education specialist who will run the land-based program from MarineLab's campus. The "Coral Restoration Workshop" will include an introduction to Mote's coral restoration research and will give students experience building field supplies and handling live corals as they learn how to prep these corals for outplanting on our reefs. Students will also participate in an outplanting simulation.

Grade Level: 5th and above

Timing: 1.5 - 3 hours, depending on group size (morning or afternoon only)

Extensions: We encourage groups who participate in this program to add on a reef restoration field trip. During the field trip they will snorkel Mote's Upper Keys nursery and a restoration site.
